



PROCEDURES FOR CAMPUS MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

Call Extension 6427, “5555” or “0”

LSUA has established procedures to follow in the event of a campus medical emergency. ***It is important that these procedures are followed.***

8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Call Extension **6427, 5555**, or **“0”** during normal work hours to activate the Emergency Response Committee in the event of a medical emergency. Provide the nature of the emergency and the location.

A member(s) of the committee along with the Campus Safety Officer will be contacted and will respond.

After 4:30 p.m.

Call University Police at 473-6427, or Extension 6427 from an on campus line. If you cannot reach them, dial 9 (for an off-campus line) and 911. The 911 operator will contact University Police.
